Introduction

Our website uses cookies.

We will ask you to consent to our use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this policy when you first visit our website. Our site is built to use cookies to enhance user experience and collect data for analytical purposes. By using our website you are agreeing to this policy & you consent to our use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this policy.

Cookies

A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

Cookies can be used by web servers to identify and track users as they navigate different pages on a website and identify users returning to a website.

Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies.

A persistent cookie consists of a text file sent by a web server to a web browser, which will be stored by the browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date (unless deleted by the user before the expiry date).

A session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

What we use

We use both session cookies and persistent cookies on this website.

Our cookies are used to remember your preferences and details for filling forms, and for highlighting linked you've visited previously. We also collect cookie info on our website and to track the analytics for site progression. Not cookies containing your personal data are relayed to us.

The Analytic cookies

When you use our website, you may also be sent third party cookies.



We use Google Analytics to analyse the use of this website. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. Google will store this information. Cookies and personal information

Cookies do not contain any information that personally identifies you, but personal information that we store about you may be linked, by us, to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.
